

## Oral presentation ESCAPE17

The papers selected for oral sessions are intended to present an important part of ESCAPE17 program as well. These contributions are considered to be attractive to capture the public interested to get transferable relevant information on the paper. In this respect it is recommended to follow the structure of the manuscript underlying the paper background and personal contribution of the authors.

Since the oral sessions are based on rigid time schedules, a regular lecture **including discussions** can last no longer than 20 minutes. Forty minutes are reserved for keynote lectures presentations including discussions and forty five minutes for Plenary lectures, including discussions.

Data projectors. Lecture rooms will be equipped with data projector/laptop provided with CD-ROM drives, USB 2.0 port for memory stick. The presentations will use PowerPoint software (version Office 2003). **We are not adapted for Macintosh software.** PCs for checking the PowerPoint presentation beforehand will be available in the Computer Room. We recommend to send us in advance your presentation, to organise properly each oral session. In the worse situation each presenter will come to the desk during the break before the session, to transfer the presentation on conference laptop in the presence of technical staff.

Oral presentation. Please consider that oral presentations address a larger audience with limited possibility for interaction, just in the discussions part of the presentation. The lectures should be presented in English. Kindly use short sentences, a slower pace of delivery, clear and distinct pronunciation. This concerns specifically those presenters who speak in their mother tongue (i.e. English).
